Airworthy	Yes
History	1960 – Purchased new by private syndicate based at RAEGC. - The second Bocian to be imported into the UK.
Notable flights	1960 - National gliding competition at Lasham - 140 miles (225 km) from Lasham to Callington - by J.E. Torode 1962 - National gliding competition at Aston Down. Often participated in aerobatic displays.
Restoration history	Refinished in present colour scheme in the late 1960's. Damaged in trailer during the storm of 1987 and restored to flying order by a group at Lasham - at which time the 1-E canopy was fitted
Other	Affectionately known as "Bertie"
