History	Its sister was built in the same Colditz Castle attics that the prisoners had used to construct the original in 1944/45. The one we have was used to sort out problems and advise solutions to the many issues that arose during the building of the replica in the Colditz attics.
Notable flights	Never flown! It's sister was launched under radio control on 17 <sup>th</sup> Mar 2012 from the roof of Colditz Castle and crashed in the originally intended landing field next to the River Mulde.
Restoration history	Not applicable.
