Moved from Bicester to the GHC at Lasham 4 Nov 2014
Notable flights	On donation to the GHC 1511 hours in 15048 launches. One Silver C duration recorded!
Restoration history	Fully restored by Peter Underwood in 1997
Other	Donated to the GHC Nov 2014 by Sir John Allison who retired from the RAF as Air Chief Marshal in 1998
