Restoration history	Last flown 1996. Restored by Dave Clarke assisted by Will Stoney 2017/2018. First flew again at Lasham 4 th Sept 2018.
Other	Restored as XS651 though this was never an ATC Swallow. Owned by Dave Clarke who recovered it from Dunstable after being in its trailer there for many years (probably since 1996). Badly damaged in the hurricane of October 1987. Was on display at the 2018 Goodwood Revival event
