History	Prototype built 1950, Flown in World Championships in Spain 1952. Exhibited in the Festival of Britain Exhibition in 1952. Dunstable Club Glider and first BGA CofA in 1953. Was at Colerne in the 1960's and came to Lasham in 1973.
Notable flights	300km 25% triangle for Gold Distance and Diamond Goal.
Restoration history	Repaired by London Sailplanes in 1952. Repaired again at Colerne and then fully restored by current owner in 1980. Recovered 2020.
