History	Bought new by Humphrey Dimock in April 1968, the second Diamant to enter the UK, first flew 21 April 1968. Humphrey was a very keen competition pilot. Up until he sold the glider in Oct 1970 to P.Wybrow he'd flown 4 big comps, 2 abroad and 2 Nationals in the UK – the 1969 one at Lasham Subsequently a number of private owner syndicates culminating with David Chapman in Aug 2007.	
Notable flights	Lots of good wave flights. Unsure if it's ever done 500k.	
Restoration history	Always been a UK glider and always well looked after and pretty regularly flown apart from 2 big gaps – 1980-1986; 2010-2019. The paperwork for the glider is outstanding.	
Other	Donated to the GHC by David Chapman and trailed down to Lasham on Sat 5 Sept 2025 from the Staffordshire GC. The Swiss Diamant is an iconic glider, one of the very first production glass gliders, a contemporary at the time of the German Bolkow Phoebus, and a significantly better glider.
