History	Alpine Sportflieger Club, Leoben Donawitz till October 1982 when donated to Chris Wills. Moved from Bicester to Lasham autumn 2003 to be cared for by the Lasham vintage group. Bequeathed to Lasham in 2011 on Chris's death. Now owned by the Gliding Heritage Centre
Notable flights	Several 100 k's, longest recorded Gary Pullen 230km in 2011
Restoration history	Restored by Gary Pullen at Lasham, winter of 2009/2010
Other	Flew 1402.21 hours in 6365 flights whilst in Austria
