History	Delivered 30/3/1950 to 89 Gliding School, Christchurch. 89 GS became 622 GS which moved to Old Sarum in 1963. Sold to the Ouse GC, Rufforth, 16/4/1985 and was registered as BGA 3148. Briefly at Lleweni Parc in 1992 but did not fly. Sold to a Lasham syndicate in 1993 where it is still based and now part of the "2-seater syndicate" with the Capstan BRW.
