

Airworthy	Yes (First flight 2/5/2021 after 18 years)
History	Sold new by Slingsbys to a GC in Berne, Switzerland, where it was HB561. Returned to the UK in 1977 and spent many years at Aboyne. To John Morgan at the Worcestershire GC from whom the current syndicate bought it in 2013.
Notable flights	Still the holder of the Swiss National free distance record – 536.2 km, Berne to Beziers (Sth France), 1955.
Restoration history	The latest restoration started in 2013 when the current owners bought it. Not completed until 2021 as so much work was required – mice had badly damaged one wing and the other had been stored in damp conditions.
Other	Current owner, Mike Borrowdale syndicate at Lasham
